As a volunteer in the west lobby being able to assist others by answering questions and helping them find their way to their destination is what Jeff likes most about volunteering but if you ask staff - they will tell you he does far more than that. One account of Jeff’s exceptional dedication comes from aide Jamie Nielsen. When Jamie was having difficulty getting a wheelchair-bound patient into a vehicle, Jeff stayed after his shift to help. He attached the ramp to the vehicle, waited to ensure the patient was safely inside the van, and then assisted the patient’s wife in securing the wheelchair to the back of the vehicle.

Jeff consistently goes above and beyond his regular duties. One great example: when a letter came loose on the Jennie Edmundson sign in the lobby, Jeff took it upon himself to step in. He coordinated with Maintenance to secure the necessary equipment, fixed the sign himself, and made sure the job was completed so the Maintenance team could head home on time. His initiative and thoughtfulness truly make a difference.

When he’s not taking on extra volunteer shifts—which he does often—Jeff enjoys outdoor activities such as fishing, bike riding, and spending time with his family. Recently, he’s also discovered a love for tackling large jigsaw puzzles.
