- Average door-to-balloon time of 64 minutes. (The National American Heart Association guidelines state that hospitals treating STEMI patients should reliably achieve a door-to-balloon time of 90 minutes or less)
- Average first medical contact to balloon time of 108 minutes for outlying communities (For patients with anticipated short transport interval (e.g. <30 minutes in urban/suburban settings), first medical contact-to-first device time of less than 90 minutes is a reasonable target; otherwise the target is less than 120 minutes)
- Dedicated chest pain unit
- The only hospital in southwest lowa that performs chronic total occlusion procedures and electrophysiology studies

Committed to providing cardiac outreach services to hometowns across SWIA

- Four days a week our cardiologists provide care in several community hospitals throughout Southwest Iowa.
- In addition to saving patients the burden of long distance travel, we continually strengthen our partnerships with the medical community as well as emergency services.
- We offer a 24/7 One-Call Patient Transfer line that coordinates and streamlines patient transfer services between Methodist Jennie Edmundson Hospital, and the referring hospital or physician.
